

# INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ACCOMMODATION

## STEP 1

### SECURE YOUR ACCOMMODATION BEFORE ARRIVING

The International Office assists international students with making informed decisions about where they live during their stay at UCT.

International students complete a webform which enables us to make relevant accommodation recommendations.

For accommodation recommendations, please scan the QR Code.



## STEP 2

### RECOMMENDATIONS ARE MADE BASED ON YOUR WEBFORM FEEDBACK

You will receive information about on and off-campus housing via email. Relevant details about the accommodation, the area and the landlord or residence, will be highlighted for you to ensure you are making an informed decision about where you decide to live.

## STEP 3

### DEADLINES, RULES AND POLICIES

Ensure that you understand on-campus accommodation deadlines, rules and fee policies. Deadlines are set and late applications will not be considered.

Ensure that the off-campus accommodation is UCT accredited and you familiarise yourself with the relevant cancellation policies and house rules.

## STEP 4

### CONFIRM YOUR HOUSING

Confirm an on-campus accommodation offer online as instructed in the offer letter.

Confirm off-campus accommodation by signing a lease agreement and paying a security deposit and signing a lease agreement with the relevant landlord.

**Before you arrive in Cape Town, print and bring along all proof of payments, signed lease agreements and any supporting documents of your confirmed accommodation.**
